

Poster Contest

Submission Opens: November 1, 2013

Submission Closes: January 10, 2014

Rules

The poster must follow a topic related to the computer industry or contain information about those involved in the industry. Each poster must have a title, an abstract, and a poster. It must be in poster form to present at the conference and in PDF form to submit via [EasyChair](#). Please add the faculty advisor(s) as last author(s) of the poster. You must submit your poster via [EasyChair](#) unless there are certain circumstances that prevent you from doing so. If you have any issues that disable you from submitting via [EasyChair](#) you must notify us immediately. You must also bring your poster to the conference for judging and peer review. Contestants must be registered for the conference. More than one person may work on a poster, but only one prize will be given per poster. The deadline for submission is January 10, 2014. Submissions on [EasyChair](#) close on January 10, 2014.

Submission

All posters must be submitted via [EasyChair](#) in PDF format. Submission opens on [EasyChair](#) on November 1, 2013. You will need to create a account with EasyChair in order to be able to submit your poster. If you encounter any problems during your submission process please refer to the [EasyChair FAQ](#) or please contact us at campana1@nku.edu. You will also be required to bring your poster to the conference so that you can display it for judging and review. Be prepared to explain your poster or answer any questions to the attendees at the conference. Submission closes on [EasyChair](#) on January 10, 2014. Any submission requests after the deadline will need to be reviewed to determine whether or not they will be permitted in the contest.

Judging

The posters will be displayed on Friday, February 7, to allow the contestant to have time to display their hard work and explain it to those at the conference. The posters will then be judged after a set amount has been given for review. The announcements of the winners will take place at the end of the conference on Saturday, February 8, during the wrap up and award ceremony.
